Methodology

This week, we conducted a special poll of Canadians and Americans to assess their views on the ongoing war in Iran.

Method

Online survey among respondents 18 years of age or older.
(Canadian sample: **n= 1,608** / American sample: **n= 1,006**)

Respondents had the option of completing the survey in French and English and were randomly recruited using LEO's online panel.

Weighting

Results were weighted according to **age, gender, mother tongue, region, education and presence of children in the household** in order to ensure a representative sample of the Canadian population, according to **age, gender, region, education, ethnicity, and number of people in the household** in order to ensure a representative sample of the American population.

When

Data collection from **March 13 to March 16, 2026**, for Canada and the United States.

Margin of error

For comparison purposes, a probability sample of this size yields a margin of error no greater than **±2.44%**, (19 times out of 20) for the Canadian sample, **±3.09%**, (19 times out of 20) for the American sample.

Significant differences

Data in bold **red** characters indicate a significantly lower proportion than that of other respondents. Conversely, data in bold **green** characters indicate a significantly higher proportion than that of other respondents.

Rounded data

The numbers presented have been rounded up. However, the numbers before rounding were used to calculate the sums presented and might therefore not correspond to the manual addition of these numbers.

Key Results

Some of **the key highlights** of our survey...

- **Interest in the conflict is equally high in Canada and the U.S. (67%), but Americans are more engaged**, with 30% saying they are following the situation very closely compared to 21% of Canadians.
- Public opinion diverges sharply on military action: **Canadians are significantly more opposed to U.S./Israel strikes on Iran** (58% opposed vs. 25% supportive), while among Americans divisions are more balanced (44% opposed, 38% supportive). In the U.S., Republicans (76%) are more likely to support the bombing of Iran.
- Canadians strongly favor neutrality, with **67% agreeing that Canada should remain neutral and not support either side**, compared to just 25% who support backing the U.S. and Israel.
- Concerns reflect different national priorities: **Canadians are primarily worried about economic impacts** (91% concerned about rising costs; 82% about a potential recession), while **Americans show a little more concern about security risks** (78% about terrorism; 76% about military involvement).
- **There is majority support in both countries for defensive military involvement, such as defending a NATO ally** (59% in Canada; 57% in the U.S.), but less support for offensive actions like regime change (39% Canada; 45% U.S.).
- The conflict is creating strong support for expanding Canada's energy production, with **74% of Canadians in favor of increasing oil and gas capacity in response to global supply disruptions**.
























